SECRETARY

TREASURER

Treasurer Marge Joder presented her report showing a cash balance as of September 30, 2006, of \$5,340.03. The report will be filed for audit.

VOTER SERVICE COMMITTEE REPORT

Voter Service Chair Susan Bookbinder reviewed opportunities the League has provided for the public to register to vote and to know the candidates and issues. The big effort between now and election day will be to get Collier County voters to the polls.

Following discussion, **Sandy Parker made a motion that was seconded and unanimously carried that the League of Women Voters of Collier County partner with the Greater Naples Chamber of Commerce to get out the vote for the forthcoming election.** Working with the Chamber, Ms. Parker has developed appropriate flyers which will be widely circulated.

Kathleen Slebodnik spoke of the League’s “Adopt a Precinct” program and its need for additional trained volunteers. It was reported that the League’s Ed Fund profited by

\$1445 for its assistance with the primary. Ms. Slobodnik stated that League's participation in a parade in Golden Gate may not be a reality this year because of the lack of League volunteers.
